QUESTIONS WITH RESPECT TO MEMBERSHIP MUST BE DIRECTED TO THE BOARD of TRUSTEES ONLY AND NOT TO THE EROS.

STEP	DATE	EVENT
1	Sunday 02 October	 The last date for membership applications/renewal to be submitted to the Masjid office 30 minutes before Isha Jamaat (to enable eligibility to vote). This date being 60 days prior to elections - per clause 11.15 of the KMA constitution. Membership forms can be obtained from the Masjid office.
2	Sunday 16 October	 Nomination forms (with candidate personal statements) for the Executive Committee and Board of Trustees* will be available from: www.kingstonmosque/Resources/PDF documents) after Zuhr. Nomination forms to be completed and emailed to the KMA election email address.
3	Friday 4 November	Last date for receipt of nomination forms at 5pm.
4	Sunday 13 November	 List of nominated candidates, photos and 'candidate personal statements' will be placed onto the Masjid website.
5	Friday 18 November	 Last date for any queries/questions (5pm) to ERO email address.
6	Saturday 03 December	 Elections start at 11.00am until 15 minutes before Asr Jamaat. Members can vote at polling booths in the Musjid. Ballot papers will be provided to KMA members on arrival. Verification against the members list will be
		conducted by the EROs. ID will be required (driving licence/utility bill showing name and address).
7	Sunday 04 December	 Elections continue from 10.30am until 15 minutes before Asr Jamaat. Verification and ID checks will be conducted as above.
		 Election results announced as soon as practical – likely to be late in the day.
